

Two-in-One “Form-A-Nator” Tool Increases Efficiency on Jobsite

LAKE WACCAMAW, N.C. – March 2006 – Council Tool Company recently introduced its new innovative “Form-A-Nator” combination tool, featuring a sledge hammer and a cutting/digging blade on opposite ends. The Form-A-Nator is the first tool of its kind on the market and provides jobsite efficiency.

The Form-A-Nator’s sledge hammer and cutter mattock blade are heat treated for strength and durability, and are made from one piece of forged alloy steel. The sledge hammer has a machined striking face, while the mattock has a tapered digging blade.

The Form-A-Nator is outfitted with a fiberglass “clad” handle that consists of a polypropylene cover that is injection-molded around a fiberglass pultrusion, giving strength and durability to the tool.

Designed by experts in the concrete industry, the Form-A-Nator can be used in and around concrete finishing and foundation jobsites, demolition applications, forcible entry and general landscaping.

“The Form-A-Nator replaces the need for carrying two tools, greatly increasing efficiency and convenience on the jobsite. It’s not often that both striking faces of a sledge are used, so the Form-A-Nator provides value by having two tools in one,” said Pickett Council, vice president, Council Tool Company.
